SELECTION OF ADMISSION

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- The candidates for admission should appear for the interview with the following original documents**
- SSLC/CBSE/ICSE Certificate
 - Qualifying certificate(+2 or equivalent)
 - Transfer certificate from their institution last attended
 - Conduct certificate from the head of the institution last attended
 - 4 copies of passport size photos
- Any other documents specified by the university from time to time. Parent or guardian should accompany the candidate at the time of interview. The original certificate will be returned only after the course or when all dues to the college are cleared**

The fee will be levied as per the fee structure at the time of Admission and as per schedule. The students should remit the semester fee in time . The name of defaulters after the last date of remittance with fine will be removed from the nominal roll without further notice
